| Annual Cohort | A group of students who share the same academic entry year. An academic entry year is defined as July 1 st to June 30 th . Students are included in the annual cohort when they matriculate. |
| Graduation Rate | The number of students in the Annual Cohort who have graduated within 150% of the normal time to earn the degree divided by the number of students in the Annual Cohort. |
